Aloha President Amaral and members of the Hawaiian Civic Clubs,

I would like to formally send this letter of congratulations to the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs for taking the courageous step to publicly announce its position that the Kingdom of Hawaii continues to exist.

In 1994, the Royal Order of Kamehameha I passed a resolution and proclaimed in 1995 at our Royal Tombs of Mauna Ala, that Our Kingdom of Hawaii still exists. Authorized by the 35th Article of the 1864 Constitution of the Kingdom of Hawaii, King Kamehameha V established the Order of Kamehameha I by Royal Decree on April 11, 1865 at Iolani Palace. The Royal Decree established our mission and authorized the Order to carry out its kuleana, in perpetuity, as an institution of the Kingdom of Hawaii.

Following the overthrow in 1893, Prince Jonah Kuhio reorganized the Order beginning in 1902. Sixteen years later (1918) Prince Kuhio established the first Hawaiian Civic Club with the assistance of several Brothers of the Order. He possessed the mana to continue the vision & purposes of Kamehameha V and perpetuate the Royal Order of Kamehameha I. The Order will continue to uphold loyalty, honor and patriotism to Our Kingdom.

The Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs' statement that The Kingdom of Hawaii continues to exist is right in line with our founder's vision and the purpose of our beloved Order.
